- Chairman's Report
 - Nigel Kinch gives his report on the last year.
 - The 2020 season was largely scuppered by COVID-19. However, the COVID Cup was a real success and lots of games were played. Good lessons have been learned which will be helpful for the 2021 season.
 - Leicester Teachers & Mosssdale have left the league. North Kilworth are new to the league and will be replacing them in Div 9.
 - There have been some changes to the Tier Rep system. The tier rep of a club's 1st XI is in will now represent the teams for the whole club.
- Treasurer's report
 - Brad Peake gives his report on the finances.
 - Income has been reduced due to COVID.
 - Everards continued with their sponsorship which has been gratefully received.
 - There is plenty of loan money available.
 - There is £13,000 grant money available and applications are welcome.

 - Chris Pople is proposed to take Vice Chairman and continue the Communications role.

 - All updated club information needs to be loaded to the club website ASAP.
 - League repayments to re-start at the end of June 2021.
 - Newly appointed captains need an ECB DBS

 - This DBS lasts for 3 years.
 - It is good practice for vice-captains to have a DBS as well.
 - Fixtures will be out near the start of February.
 - If the season starts with no teas, then there will be no enforcement of needing to provide teas for the rest of the season.
 - Game start times remain the same.
 - Home teams will be expected to provide the hand sanitiser for matches, but it would be good practice for away teams to bring their own as well.
